

SWA DRESS CODE EXPECTATIONS

Southern Wake Academy has a dress code that ensures all students are dressed in a manner that promotes school pride and presents a positive impression in the community during internships, job-shadowing activities, and community service projects. *As a condition of being enrolled at SWA, students and parents agree to comply with the dress code and are, thus expected to follow it daily.* Students arriving at school in non-compliant clothing will be asked to return home to change.

Students must always be in uniform while on campus unless involved in a SWA after-school sport, when appropriate sports uniform or practice attire should be worn.

ATTIRE	COLORS	ADDITIONAL NOTES
Pants, Shorts, Skirts	Tan, Navy, Black ~ SOLID colors only	All students must wear tan, navy, or black dress pants or khaki pants, shorts, or skirts. They must be SOLID colors only. No denim, sweatpants, athletic pants, yoga pants, tights, or leggings. No sagging pants.
Shirts	Red, Cobalt, Black, Heather Grey, Light Blue, or Evergreen	Solid color official uniform polo shirts must be worn and are to be purchased from the designated uniform vendor, Lands' End, and will bear the school logo. Use the portal on our website, www.swake.org , to access SWA's school store at Lands' End.
Shoes	Any color	Closed Toe/Closed Heel shoes must be worn, any color. Open toe/open heel shoes of any kind (– i.e., Crocs, flip-flops, slippers, or sliders) are NOT permitted.
Headwear		No headwear is permitted – no hats, bandanas or scarves which cover the head, unless for religious purposes / reasons.
Body Piercings		Except for earrings worn on the ears, all other body piercings (nose, lips, etc.) must be removed for school.
Jewelry		Any jewelry or accessories that could be used as a weapon (such as chains or spiked jewelry) are NOT permitted.
Dress Down Days		On selected Fridays, students will be permitted to wear SWA spirit wear with UNIFORM BOTTOMS
